#### Covid Update

Following a meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> January of the Parliamentary Task Group on Public Worship attended by the Cardinal with other Faith Leaders, a Government Guidance Document on Public Worship was issued. The safety measures employed at St. William of York were subsequently reviewed and with just one additional provision - increased ventilation of the Church during services, it was agreed to proceed with Masses from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January.

Parishioners are reminded of the 3 key points when attending – to wear face masks at all times, observe safe distancing and no intermingling with other households either before or after Mass.

#### **Church Safety Arrangements**

- Face Masks must be worn at all times whilst in the Church,
- Please observe safe distancing and no intermingling between households,
- Follow the one-way traffic flow system that is in place,
- Please follow the direction of the Marshals on the seating arrangements, and stay in the assigned pew seat; a restricted number of 42 remains in place which will be adhered to.
- Holy Communion is distributed after the final Prayers and Blessing, with Parishioners expected to exit the Church, not returning to their seat,
- The Toilet facility remains out of use,
- Hand sanitizers are sited at the Entrance and Exit from the Church for personal use,
- The weekly newsletter will be available for collection on leaving, with baskets placed for the Offertory offerings,
- If you are <u>feeling unwell</u>, suffering from a cold or cough, please do not attend Church.
